

The Feast of Trumpets

This festival was held on the first day of the Seventh month (Tishri), and was celebrated by the blowing of trumpets which is why it is called trumpets!

The feast of Trumpets is observed by the church today as God has commanded us to do. See Leviticus 23:23-25

Trumpets were often used to sound an alarm for war and also as a instrument for the watchmen to arouse the population if danger threatened. See Ezekiel 33:1-16

In the book of Numbers chapter 10 we have a little more understanding concerning these trumpets that were blown. There were two special trumpets made for the people of Israel.

Numbers 10:2,5,9.tells us that they can be used or sounded for a calling of an assembly or for an alarm or warning and thirdly to prepare for war!

Revelation 8 and 9.tell us that trumpets have a lot to do with the fulfilling of what God has planned in the events leading up to the return of the Lord Jesus Christ.
